⇒ <b>Detergent caps</b>	⇒ <b>Peanut butter lids</b>	
⇒ <b>Drink bottle caps</b>	⇒ <b>Prescription bottles – labels removed</b>	
⇒ <b>Flip-top caps</b>

clean!**
