

Asbestos Management Plan 2018-2019

To all district employees, building occupants, parents, teacher and employee organizations: In compliance with the asbestos hazard emergency response act, this communication is a mandate concerning the district's asbestos management plan and asbestos activities. The management plan contains information regarding the location of asbestos containing materials (ACM) in all school buildings, the conditions of the ACM and a plan for dealing with the ACM. At least once a year, the district will inform you in a similar manner about asbestos activities including: inspections, periodic surveillance, response actions and post response action activities that are planned or in progress.

REINSPECTIONS: An inspection of all district buildings is required by law every three years, after implementation of the management plan. Our next inspection will be conducted July 2019.

PERIODIC SURVEILLANCE: Once every six months, ACM must be visually inspected for changes in condition. This inspection will be performed by Glen McMunn. Our next periodic surveillance is tentatively scheduled for January 2019.

RESPONSE ACTIONS: These are activities designed to reduce / eliminate the potential for asbestos hazards. In general, the ACM present in district buildings include: pipe insulation, joints, valves and valve fittings in the boiler room area and tunnels located in the elementary school. These items are also located in the boiler room, Industrial Arts room and the tunnels in the high school. Other ACM areas will be repaired, if damaged, and maintained by district maintenance personnel in accordance with the district operations and maintenance program (O&M).
